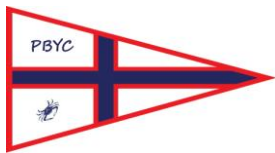

NOTICE OF RACE



Port Bouvard Yacht Club (PBYC), the Organising Authority in conjunction with the Pelican Sailing Association (Inc.), invite entries to the 3rd and 4th of March Regatta.

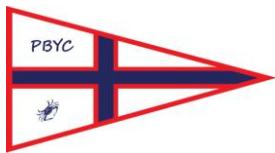
1 RULES

The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 (RRS) including the Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia and the rules of the Pelican Sailing Association (Inc).

“Competitors attention is directed to the requirements of YA Special Regulations Part 2 rule 5.01 PFD's which will be enforced.”

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Entry is open to all skippers and crew who are financial members of both a club affiliated with Yachting Australia (YA) & the Pelican Sailing Association (Inc) and possess a current YA Youth membership card, and are under 16 years of age on the 15th of October 2012.
- 2.2 The regatta is open to boats currently registered with Pelican Sailing Association (Inc).
- 2.3 The hull and equipment shall comply with the Rules of Construction and Measurement of the Pelican Sailing Association (Inc).
- 2.4 Eligible boats may be entered by completing the entry, indemnity and payment details form attached to this Notice of Race and lodging them with the Secretary of the Port Bouvard Yacht Club, either by post or email as noted on the payment details form by Tuesday 28th February 2012.
- 2.5 Late entries will be accepted up to 0900 hours on Saturday 3rd of March 2012. A late registration fee of \$15.00 will be applied to those entries.
- 2.6 A change of skipper or crew will be approved only in exceptional circumstances and provided a request is made in writing at least 1 hour prior to the race affected. Approval, if given, will be in writing.

3 FEES

- Regatta Entry - \$15.00
- Camping - \$20.00 per night per family. (NO Pets)

4 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

The regatta will comprise of a six (6) races which will be scheduled as follows:

Note; These race times are preliminary only and can change at any time at the discretion of the Race Committee to achieve the maximum number of races within the two days available.

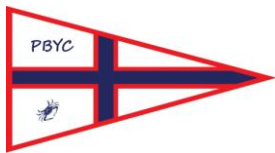
A briefing will be held on Saturday 3rd March at 0900 at the Port Bouvard Yacht Club Clubhouse. Other briefings will be held at the discretion of the Race Committee.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available to each boat at the regatta briefing at 0900 hours on Saturday the 3rd of March 2012 at the Port Bouvard Yacht Club house.

6 PROTESTS AND MEDIATION

A protest by a boat lodged in accordance with rule 61 which alleges an infringement of a rule of Part 2, Part 4 or rule 28 will be subject to mediation. Such hearings will be held subsequent to protests being lodged and prior to protest hearings. Rules for the mediation will be described in full in the sailing instructions.



NOTICE OF RACE



A protest shall be lodged on the water to the finish boat before the start of the next race or before coming ashore. Once ashore the protest shall be submitted upon a protest form. If the request for protest is not lodged to the finish boat on the water, a protest shall not be accepted and all race positions shall stand.

7 REGATTA SITE

The site is the Port Bouvard Yacht Club clubhouse and grounds.

8 RACING AREA

Racing will be conducted on the portion of Harvey Estuary in front of the Port Bouvard Yacht Club.

9 COURSES

The courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

10 SCORING

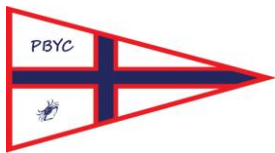
The Low Point Scoring System as per Appendix A of the RRS will apply. The Regatta will be decided over 6 heats of which the boat's Championship score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's Championship score will be the total of her race scores. A minimum of 3 heats will constitute a series, unless decided otherwise by the Race Committee.

A consistency scoring system will be run in conjunction with the championship series. Each boat's Handicap will be calculated by the Organising Authority using the finishing times of the boat's first three races. Correspondence regarding handicap system will not be entered into.

Any boat that finishes in the top three overall positions shall be ineligible to win a position in the top three positions on consistency.

11 TROPHIES AND SHIELDS

The trophies will be awarded to Helm person and Crew as follows:



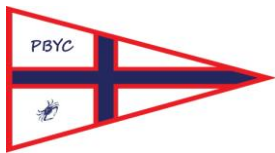

Definition of a First year Skipper - "A first year skipper is a skipper who has not skippered any class of yacht before the last State Championships. He/she is considered a First Year Skipper from after a State Championship to the next State Championships."

Cash prizes will also be awarded to the first boat around the first mark. "Dash for cash"

12 DISCLAIMER

- 12.1 All those taking part in races conducted by the Port Bouvard Yacht Club do so at their own risk.
- 12.2 The Port Bouvard Yacht Club., Pelican Sailing Association (Inc),any sponsor and any other party involved in the organization of the event disclaims any and every responsibility for any loss, damage, injury to persons and things, both ashore and on the water, as a consequence of participation in any way in the races covered by this Notice of Race.
- 12.3 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million for any one incident. By taking part in a race or event, owners are deemed to have made a declaration that they have such cover.
- 12.4 Attention is drawn to Rule 4 which states that "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone."

13 RIGHT TO USE NAME & LIKENESS

Competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any text, motion pictures, video and still pictures, as well as live, taped or filmed television of, or relating to, this regatta upon signing the entry form.

14 RADIO COMMUNICATION

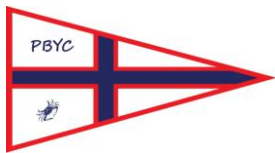
A boat shall neither make radio transmission while racing, nor received any radio communication not available to all boats. Mobile phones are a radio communication device.

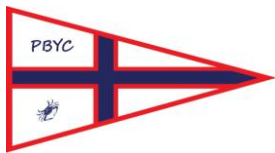

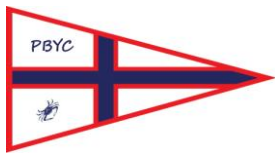
