# **NOTICE OF RACE**

# RUMBLE IN THE REACH SATURDAY 18<sup>th</sup> JANUARY 2020

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The Organising Authority is East Fremantle Yacht Club (Inc.).
- 1.2 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions and special regulations of Australia Sailing, Navigable Waters Regulations and the Class Rules of the O'pen Skiff, Pelican, Sabre and National 125.

#### 2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Advertising on a boat shall comply with ISAF Regulation 20 (ISAF Advertising Code).
- 2.2 An application for entry shall contain brief details of all advertising that a boat proposes to carry. The Organising Authority shall be advised of any changes to that advertising.

#### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The regatta is open to all National 125's, Sabres, Open Skiffs and Pelicans. Helmspersons are invited to nominate for entry by completing the attached entry form and by e-mailing it to activities@efyc.com.au or posting it to:

Nomination forms and payment must be received no later than 5pm Monday 13th January 2020.

#### 4. FEES

An entry fee of \$25 per single / \$40 per double-handed boat will apply (Includes lunch for all competitors).

#### 5. SCHEDULE

The regatta will consist of up to 3 races per class. The warning signal for the first race is scheduled for 0955 hrs. A 3-minute start sequence shall apply.

#### 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available from Friday 17<sup>th</sup> January and at the mandatory pre-race briefing on Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> January at 0900hrs in the Junior Training Room at EFYC.

#### 7. VENUE AND COURSES

Racing will be conducted on the Swan River directly in front of the EFYC Clubhouse.

#### 8. SCORING

The Low Point System will apply. The overall result for a boat will be determined by the boat's aggregate score taking into account all races.

#### 9. PRESENTATIONS

Prizes and results will be announced and presented in the EFYC Clubhouse at approximately 1330hrs.

A perpetual trophy will be awarded to the first boat based on its aggregate score. Prizes will also be awarded to the second and third boat based on their aggregate scores. There must be 6 or more boats per fleet to qualify the fleet for Prizes.

Boats finishing in 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each race will be awarded EFYC pennants.

There will also be miscellaneous Prizes awarded at the organising authorities' discretion.

#### 10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 10.1 All those taking part in this event do so at their own risk.
- 10.2 The East Fremantle Yacht Club, any sponsor and any other party involved in the organisation of the event disclaims any and every responsibility for any loss, damage, injury to persons and things, both ashore and on the water, as a consequence of participation in any way in the races covered by this Notice of Race.
- 10.3 Attention is drawn to RRS Rule 4 which states "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue *racing* is hers alone."
